

Sprinter Overdriver Shelf 2019-2022 (VS30)



Thank you for purchasing the Off Highway Van Sprinter Overdriver Shelf. A convenient and sturdy overhead headliner shelf designed to hold window shades or curtains, as well as everyday items that you might need quicker access to while on the road, or at the trailhead. Take back space in your Sprinter and utilize a part of the van that's often overlooked. Easy to install, and a solid, trustworthy design you'd come to expect from OHV. This installation guide is meant to direct you through the easy and seamless installation process. Before beginning the assembly, visually inspect all components for defects in finish or craftsmanship and check that you have all the necessary hardware. Welcome to the OHV Crew.

- 5/32" OR 4MM HEX TOOL

Installation (Total Estimated Time - 1 Hour)

- 1. Remove rear-most (Away from the front of the van) 4mm bolts from the factory mounted shelves
- 2. PLACE THE FRONT SHELF BRACKETS (PHOTO BELOW) BEHIND THE FACTORY SHELF MOUNTING POINT THAT WAS JUST REMOVED, AND REPLACE THE BOLT THAT WAS JUST REMOVED. TIGHTEN WITH THE LARGER PORTION OF THE BRACKET WITH THE TWO HOLES FACING UP.



3. Remove the rubber hook cover, and remove the T-25 bolt holding the metal hook.

4. Place the rear shelf brackets (photo below) behind the trim, bolt, and hook that was just removed. Replace the T25 bolt through the trim, hook, and mount. Tighten with the larger part of the bracket with two holes facing up and replace the rubber hook cover that was removed.



- 5. REPEAT ON THE OPPOSITE SIDE
- 6. WITH THE HELP OF A FRIEND, PLACE THE MAIN SHELF ON TOP OF THESE BRACKETS AND LINE UP THE CORRESPONDING BOLT HOLES.
- 7. Place a washer under the buttonhead and push the buttonhead screw up through the bottom of the bracket and through the main shelf. Place the other washer on top of the shelf over the screw and begin hand-threading the 7/16" nylon-insert nut onto the screw and washer. Use the 5/32" or 4mm allen key and an open ended 7/16 wrench to tighten and snug down all 8 bolts front and back, on both sides, with washers under each buttonhead, and under each nut.





8. Using a drill, drive the final two phillips head screws into the front two mounting holes to fully secure the shelf.



- 9. Lay down the liner/mat
- 10. Enjoy a beverage for your hard work and gain back usable space in your Sprinter Van.
